

## ANNUAL REPORT 2021-22

Since the dawn of pandemic on the earth a revolutionary change has taken place in the field of education. The unexpected and unprecedented has replaced the all-time-favourite conventional ways of teaching and learning process in the school. Changes in the field of education have been taken positively which further will help the educators to enhance their methodologies and to upgrade them.

The school under the guiding hands of an effervescent management is on the path of progress. Even when the students were confined to the four walls in online education, the faculty left no stone unturned to bring smiles on the faces of SDPIans.

This year the classes were held online. MS Teams App was being used by the school as it happens to be the safest software of all which is secured by school password. The students learnt their lessons on screen with the help of videos, ppts and various other tech-modes.

Even the examination was conducted online. The students wrote their exams at the given time under the supervision of invigilator. They uploaded their answer sheets on MS Teams only. Many more softwares like adobe, Spark, Canva, Filmora, Flipgrid etc were used during this year.

It is a matter of proud to announce the CBSE results of the year. **In class XII**, out of 195 students 180 students were placed in 1<sup>st</sup> division with 568 distinctions.

Bushra from Humanities stream made us proud with 96.2 %marks. Ananya Sidhu and Yash Singhal proved themselves to be the best in Science stream (medical and non-medical respectively). They stood as toppers with 97.2 and 97.4% marks respectively. Ananya Rana got her name inscribed in golden by securing 97.6% marks in Commerce stream.

**In class X**, out of 153 students 109 students were placed in 1<sup>st</sup> division with as many as 474 distinctions.

Akansha Chiripal and Anubhav Siddhu were the school toppers with 95.2% marks. The school feels rejuvenated at having such brilliant students in the school.

INTER SCHOOL competitions– Each and every subject can be enhanced by going in for various competitions. This lockdown period has brought an ocean of opportunities and our students really excelled very well. Participating in a gamut of competitions ranging from class PS to XII and English to maths, science SST or calls for a recognition. Whether it is a dance competition or music, art or sport, tech related innovation or drama, our students have earned name and fame from every corner of the school.

Flux 2021 – Annual Inter- School Fest was organised online wherein 15 major events were designed by nearly thirty coordinators. There were 900 participants from classes PS – XII from 80 schools. The events were so designed that the children from all categories could easily participate and bring out their hidden talent. The events as designed were - Voiceart, Actomania, Mathemagic, Narrathon, Rhythm Divine, Rangmanch, Hunar Haat, Udghoshak, Future Buzztech, Commersys, Jhankaar Beats, Scratch Wizard, Fusion Yoga, Blog Tech, Disable the Disability. There were 3 live events as well - Future Buzztech, Commersys, Disable the disability. The rolling trophy was awarded to the winning school. It was a mega event and a grand success though virtually.

EVENTS AND ASSEMBLIES– No way do we let the children feel that they are at home. An absolute structured environment is created through online platform only. We have celebrated all the occasions including national festivals, teachers' day, Basant Panchmi ,

children's day, Diwali, Gurupurab, Investiture, Scholar Badge ceremony, Raksha Bandhan, Janamashtmi, Founders' Day, Christmas, Grandparents day etc. Road safety week and Fit India week celebration were vital means of bringing life to the mundane routine. The students participate enthusiastically and are ecstatic as they get to do something different every day. Although it is all on a virtual platform, doesn't fade their excitement away.

**Disney World Tour** which was an innovative idea to help the children of Pre- School to Class V to travel to the world of Disney in a virtual tour. It was a week full of activities which started on 5 October 2021 with a Disney Kick Off Dance and ended on 9 October 2021. The chain of activities seemed to be endless and unbroken. Disney Junior Jamboree was a great success. It was followed by UN POCO LOCO, Alice Whirl Twirl and Moana's Magical Meal.

The children from various schools participated in the virtual tour and it was a great learning experience for the kids of kindergarten. Such activities help the children to kindle their imagination and travel far and wide to the fairy world. It is true that children learn faster when they visualise the live streaming of the events. There were certain curtain raiser activities like – curtain raiser of Disney characters – Disney in Theatre, Disney Marathon. Disney world was alive with Disney movies on Cinderella, Snow White and the Seven Dwarfs, The Lion King and Alice in Wonderland.

AIL – A very well planned system was organized for Art Integrated learning activities. Each class, each student and each subject was taken up to integrate art in learning. **STEAM-** We run as many as 25 clubs to polish the skills of the students. The students perform activities and unleash their talents related to their interests. A mega event named steam is an effort to amalgamate the activities held under various clubs. The winners were felicitated in a function held online.

**HOUSE ACTIVITIES-** The entire year throbbled with various activities under four houses named- Kirti, Niti, Pragati and Shanti.

**CBSE ACTIVITIES AND COMPETITIONS-** An array of activities were arranged by CBSE and they all were taken up with zeal and zest. Expression Series, Rashtriya Ekta Diwas, National Science Day, Toy fair, Veer Gatha Project, Wet Waste Management were the centre of attraction.

**HOBBY CLASSES-** we have been focusing on the holistic development of the children of our school. The Hobby Classes involve a mix of prayers, exercises dance, music vocal and instrumental, Students learn various dance forms including hip hop, zumba, freestyle, and classical. Students were also evaluated for their dancing skills via Diagnostic Tests.
