ANNUAL REPORT 2022 - 23

SDPS, East Punjabi Bagh strongly believes in nurturing the blooming buds under the umbrella of moral values, modern techniques and innovative pedagogy. A revolutionary change has taken place in the field of education. The unexpected and unprecedented has replaced the all-time-favourite conventional ways of teaching and learning process in the school. Changes in the field of education have been taken positively which further will help the educators to enhance their methodologies and to upgrade them.

The school under the guiding hands of an effervescent management is on the path of progress. Everyday a new activity is taken care of to nurture the hidden talent of the students.

It is a matter of pride to announce the CBSE results for the year 2022 - 23. Total number of students who appeared was 108 and there were 272 distinctions. Akansha Chiripal from Commerce Stream scored 95.75%. Khushi from Humanities was able to score 93.25%, Himani Sharma from -Medical Stream was able to attain 92% and Anubhav Siddhu from Non - Medical Stream landed up with 90.75%.

In class X, out of 108 students, 272 students were placed in distinction. Harkirat Singh scored 95.2% and he scored 99 marks in Maths Standard, Science and Social Science.

INTER SCHOOL competitions— Each and every subject can be enhanced by going in for various competitions. An ocean of opportunities was provided and our students really excelled very well. The children participated in a gamut of competitions ranging from class PS to XII in various disciplines from English to Maths, Science and SST. Whether it was a dance competition or music, art or sport, tech related innovation or drama, our students earned name and fame.

Flux 2022 – Annual Inter- School Fest was organized online wherein 14 major events were designed.. There were 750 participants from classes PS – XII from 60 schools. The events were so designed that the children from all categories could easily participate and bring out their hidden talent. The events as designed were - Rubble Wrap, Poetic Pulse, Nurture Nature, Ingenuity With Shapes, Manch Abhinay, Freedom @75, Creative Bot, Kesariya, Geo Magic Mandalas and Planet Prithvi - Alien - de - Transformers The rolling trophy was awarded to the winning school. It was a mega event and a grand success though virtually.

EVENTS AND ASSEMBLIES – We have celebrated all the occasions including national festivals, teachers' day, Basant Panchmi, children's day, Diwali, Gurupurab, Investiture, Raksha Bandhan, Janamashtmi, Christmas, etc. Road safety week was celebrated in the school premises spreading awareness amongst the children. The students participated enthusiastically and we're ecstatic as they got to do something different every day.

AIL – A very well planned system was organized for Art Integrated learning activities. Each class, each student and each subject was taken up to integrate art in learning. Out of the box ideas were carved to get the children interested in doing such activities.

PRISM - THE CAREER CONCLAVE - Several famous universities displayed their exhibits in the multi-purpose hall. The students had the opportunity to clarify their doubts and have a crystal-clear vision about their dream universities. It was a moment of pride when the neighboring schools also had the opportunity to visit the school premises and discover their true self. The school thrived into activity and the illumination of excitement could be reflected

on the faces of the children. The parent community found it really invigorating. The one-to-one session culminated with a broader spectrum and a clear vision.

WINTER CARNIVAL - SDPS, East Punjabi Bagh organized its maiden/first ever winter carnival with great zeal and enthusiasm on 24 Dec, 2022. The happy, exuberant faces of the children coupled with the infectious energy of teachers was ubiquitous, a further testimony to the fact that the event was a stupendous success. The scenic depiction of Christmas right at the entrance to reception transported the visitors to a land of joy and wonder.

ALUMNI MEET - This was just another milestone when the school invited all the old grads of the school and had a gala show for them. The evening transformed into memories, from the past as well as the present. The children wanted to visit their classrooms where they had occupied the benches as students.

EXCURSIONS - Various excursions were planned throughout the year. The destinations were chosen with utmost care - age appropriate. Visits to temples, monuments, day long excursions helped the children learn various skills - cooperation, patience, sharing and caring and many more. Their emotional development of the child was the main focus area.

INNOVATION FEST - An innovation fest was organised in the school premises. All the children from classes III — XI participated and they were too enthusiastic to depict their skills in the form of models. There were nearly 19 exhibits and around 100 children came out with brilliant ideas. These exhibits were not limited to one or two topics — there was a galaxy of innovative ideas from various resources. These exhibits were made in the guidance of the mentors in the school and the material that was used was easily available — either the wastewater bottles, simple toy cars, cardboard boxes or tubes.
